
Good meeting guide traffic light cards

They talked about what they looked like and how they used them.




They decided that 2 cards would be enough and they would look like this







How to use these cards in a meeting






This card can be used when you want to ask a question



Or if you aren't sure about something and you would like it explaining





This can be used if you want the meeting to stop for some reason



Or to let co-chairs know that you aren't happy about something



Or if you would like to say something



You can print the cards here and use them in your meetings.




You will need to cut them out.




It would be best to print them on card instead of paper. You could also laminate them then keep them both together.

Use this if you are printing onto yellow coloured card
