The following medicines may be prescribed by practices that are contracted by North Yorkshire County Council to deliver this service, when prescribed in conjunction with North Yorkshire Horizons shared care support. Prescribing out-with this formulary will be subject to *prior* agreement with the NYH clinical team, and commissioners, prior to initiation:

- Methadone Hydrochloride: Solution 1mg/ml or 1mg/ml sugar free
- Buprenorphine Hydrochloride: sub lingual tablets 400mcg, 2mg, 8mg
- Buprenorph HCl/Naloxone HCl: Tablets 2mg/500mcg and 8mg/2mg

Generic prescriptions should be written.

GP based Pharmacological Abstinence Therapy Supervision Service for Alcohol Misuse (20 practices currently contracted to deliver)

The following medicines may be prescribed within this service, subject to the formal discharge of a service user from North Yorkshire Horizons for time limited prescribing following successful completion of a medically assisted alcohol withdrawal programme:

- Acamprosate: 333mg (adults aged 18 years to 65 years; see BNF if weighs <60kgs)
- Naltrexone: 50mg (adults aged 18 years)
- Disulfiram: 200mg
