


	<p>Transforming Care - Michelle Haggar</p> <p>Michelle said the aims of Transforming Care are about making sure:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • less people are in hospital. • people do not stay in hospital longer than they need.

	<p>Care and Treatment Reviews - Hakan Durmaz, NHS Care Treatment Lead</p> <p>Hakan told us about Care and Treatment Reviews. They help people with Learning Disability, autism or mental health needs get the right care and support.</p>

People with autism - Natasha said that Learning Disability Liaison Nurses cannot work with people with just autism.

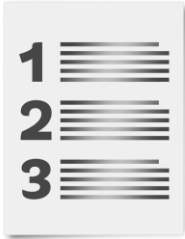
