We talked about what things look like for families if we are getting it right.



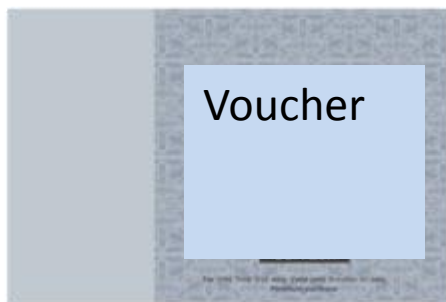
We heard from Martin Wilson who talked about using a personal budget to get a great life. He supported George to be able to train in dance.
