	These are the action points we discussed at the October 2019 meeting.
	1. <b>Have an update on transitions for young disabled people.</b> There will be more news in 2020. Shanna will invite Karl Podmore and Cara Nimmo to the next Partnership Board meeting.
	2. <b>Update on the red actions in the Live Well Live Longer annual health checks action plan.</b> This has been completed and turned to green.
	3. <b>Help make Safe Places work better.</b> Mark went to a Safe Places meeting and discussed it at the October meeting. This work is ongoing.
	4. <b>Update on actions agreed with the Chairs of the Partnership Board, the Safeguarding Adults Board and the Health and Wellbeing Board.</b> There has been lots of work about Keeping Safe as discussed at the meeting (see minutes). The Chairs of the Safeguarding Adults Board and the Health and Wellbeing Board could not attend today but we will invite them to a meeting in 2020.



5. **Christopher to write a letter about employment for people with learning disabilities at NYCC to the three Assistant Directors: Dale Owens, Chris Jones-King and Rachel Bowes, copy to Richard Webb.** A letter was sent direct to Richard Webb and a copy sent to the Assistant Directors. Jonathan will receive a full response. We will talk about employment and also Richard Webb's letter at the meeting in March 2020.



6. **Shanna to follow up Christopher's reference with NYCC.** Shanna did this and will discuss with Christopher in person. Members of Partnership Board said they would like to know about the outcome of the reference.
