- (c) General Updates, to include reports of recent meetings of the thematic boards and outside bodies. Emails which ask for text for this report have been sent to Mary Weastell, Ian Stokes and Neil Irving and to Cllrs Smalley, Lee and Arnold in respect of the European Structural and Investment Funds Sub-Committee.
