

**Chief Executives' Group – North Yorkshire and York
3 June 2019**

Representation on the North Yorkshire Health and Wellbeing Board

1 Purpose of the Report

- 1.1 To advise the Group of a decision by the North Yorkshire Health and Wellbeing Board (“the Board”) concerning representation on it

2 Background

- 2.1 The Board is a Committee established by statute (Health and Social Care Act 2012) and comprises a mix of statutory and non-statutory Members.
- 2.3 One of the non-statutory categories of membership is that for *District Council Chief Executives Representative* who represents the views of the Districts and reports back to them on the issues considered at the Board. Janet Waggott currently fulfils this role and has done so for a number of years.
- 2.3 The Board were informed that there did not appear to be a defined period for which non-statutory Members were appointed. As a result and to give consistency, the Board has agreed that non-statutory Members be appointed until the County Council elections in 2021. This does not mean that 2021 will necessarily be an end date; the Members concerned can, of course, be renominated by their respective organisation(s) at that time.

3 Recommendation

- 3.1 The Group is asked to note that, in accordance with the decision of the Board, providing Janet Waggott is happy to continue and the Group are agreeable to this, she will continue to be the representative of the District Councils Chief Executives on the Board until at least the County Council Elections in 2021.
