What is hate crime?

Any criminal offence which is perceived by the victim or any other person, to be motivated by hostility or prejudice, based on a person's:

- Disability or perceived disability
- Race or perceived race
- Religion or perceived religion
- Sexual orientation or perceived sexual orientation
- Transgender identity or perceived transgender identity
- Misogyny (NYP)
- Sex Worker (NYP)

As a hate crime champion, you will...

- Be a visible and supporting presence within your organisation for colleagues who may want to discuss a hate crime or obtain advice.
- Signpost colleagues to appropriate means of reporting and support services.
- Be a trusted adult to young people who may be a victim or have witnessed hate crime.
- Receive regular updates on what is being done to tackle hate crime in North Yorkshire.



- Be contacted by North Yorkshire Council and North Yorkshire police to share key messages regarding hate crime with you.
- Share key messages within your organisation. Ensure hate crime materials are displayed and available within your organisation.
